CADANGAN MEWUJUDKAN UNDANG-UNDANG BARU

Tujuan memorandum ini adalah untuk mendapatkan pertimbangan dan persetujuan Jemaah Menteri ke atas cadangan untuk:

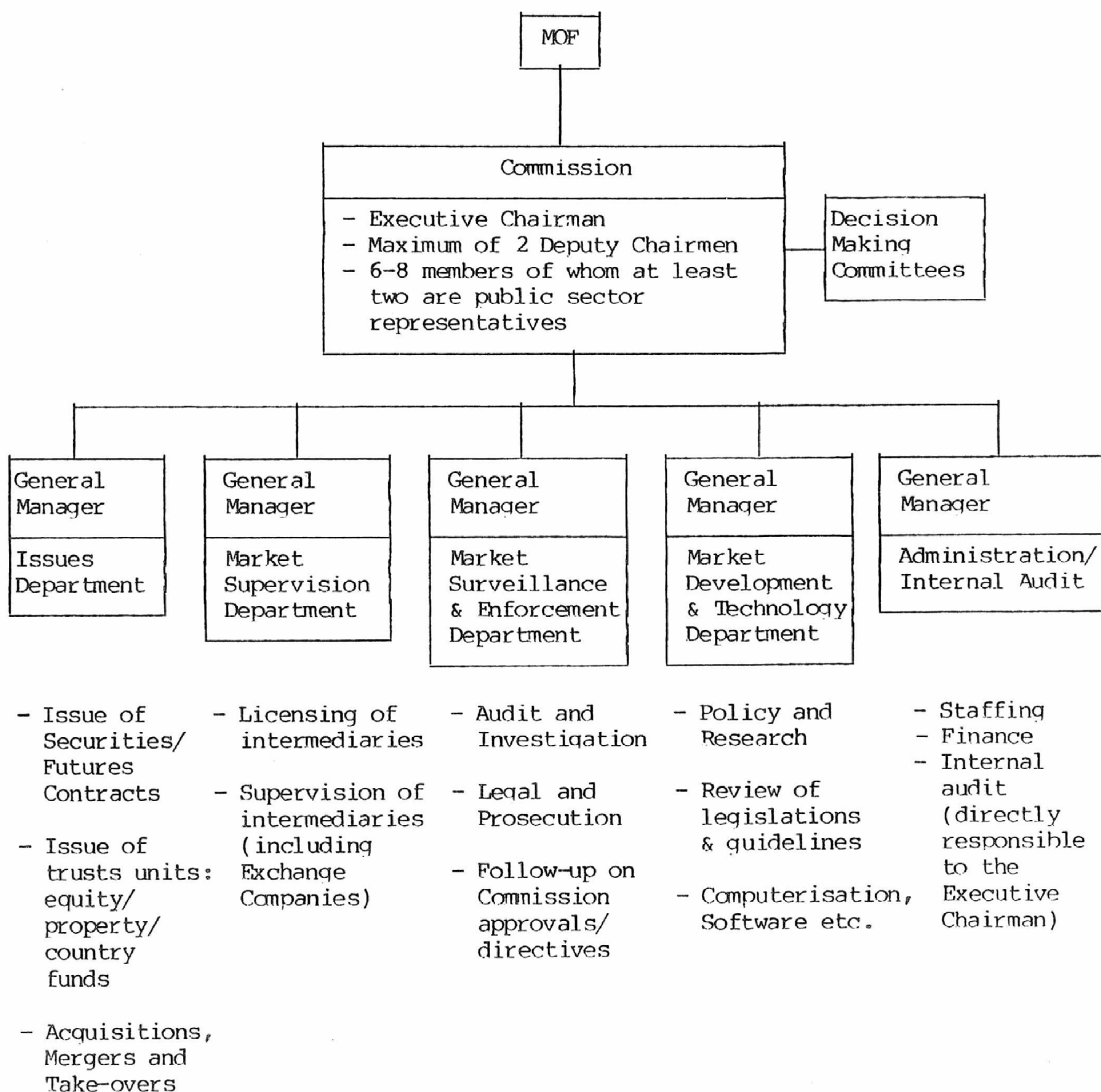
- (i) mewujudkan satu akta baru yang dinamakan "Akta Suruhanjaya Sekuriti 1992" untuk membolehkan penubuhan satu badan pengawalan industri sekuriti dan kewangan hadapan; dan
- (ii) membentangkan Rang Undang-undang berkenaan di semua peringkat dalam persidangan Parlimen yang akan berlangsung pada bulan Oktober 1992 kelak.

2. Rang Undang-undang bagi mewujudkan Akta baru, iaitu Akta Suruhanjaya Sekuriti 1992 adalah seperti di Lampiran A. Peruntukan-peruntukan utama yang diwujudkan dalam Rang Undang-undang itu adalah meliputi perkara-perkara, antara lain, seperti berikut:-

1991 Adalah dimaklumkan bahawa semasa membentangkan Belanjawan 1992 di Dewan Rakyat pada 1 hb November 1991, Yang Berhormat Menteri Kewangan (YBMK) telah mengumumkan bahawa Kerajaan akan menyusun semula badan-badan yang mentadbir dan menyelaras pasaran modal melalui sebuah pengawal iaitu Suruhanjaya Sekuriti. YBMK telah mengumumkan bahawa Suruhanjaya yang akan ditubuhkan pada 1992 akan diberi ruang dan kuasa yang secukupnya bagi mengawasi pasaran dengan berkesan.

Prior to 1976, the securities industry was almost entirely self-regulatory. Over the years, there has been increased interest by investors as more companies come for listing as well as to raise funds from the corporate securities markets. As the capital market has become more important source of funds, the need to rationalise and streamline the legislative and regulatory framework for the Malaysian securities industry has become critical.

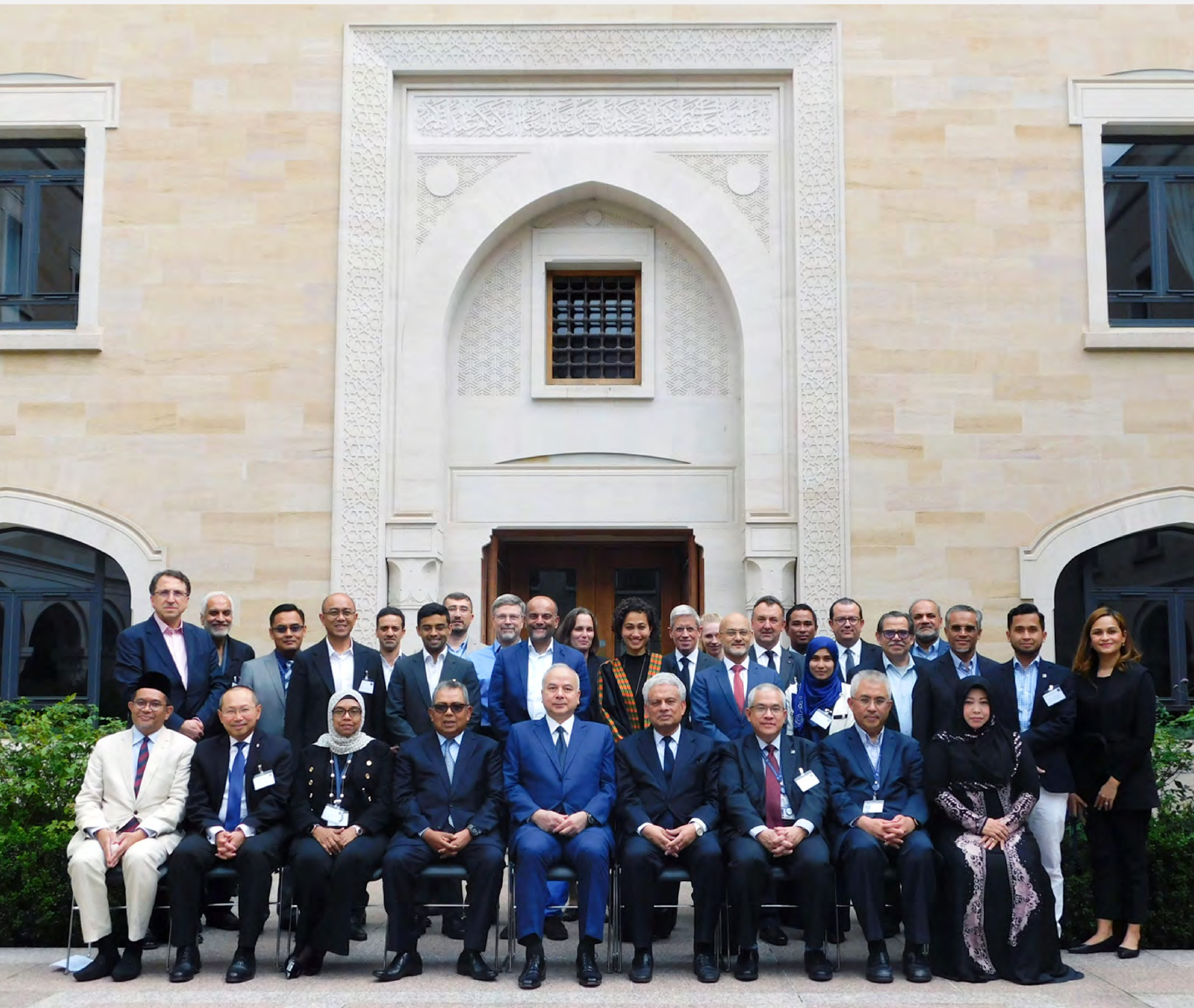

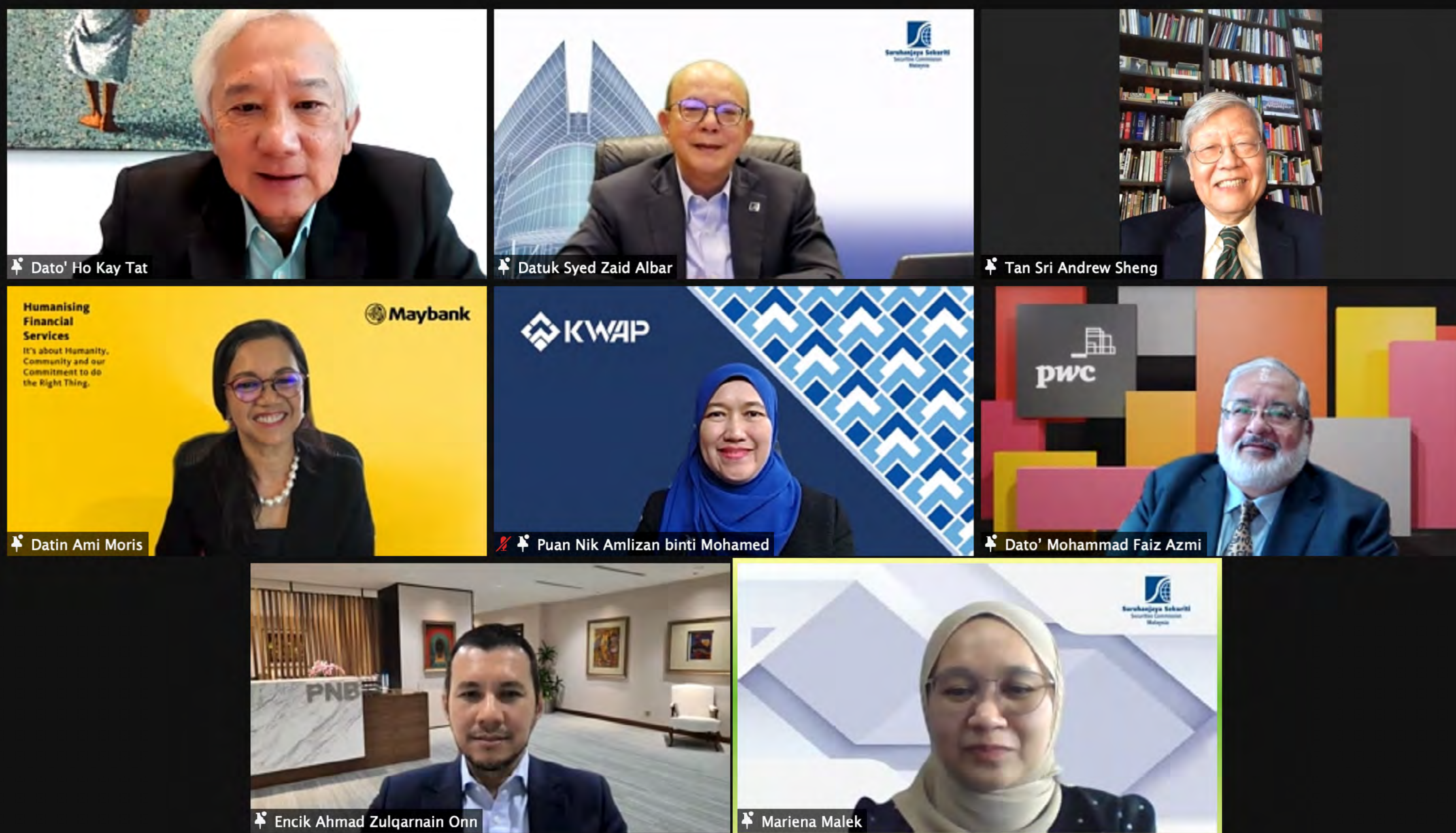

2015 The big Kelantan floods. In response to the disaster, SC staff came together to help out by organising collections for donations of food, clothing and other essential items.



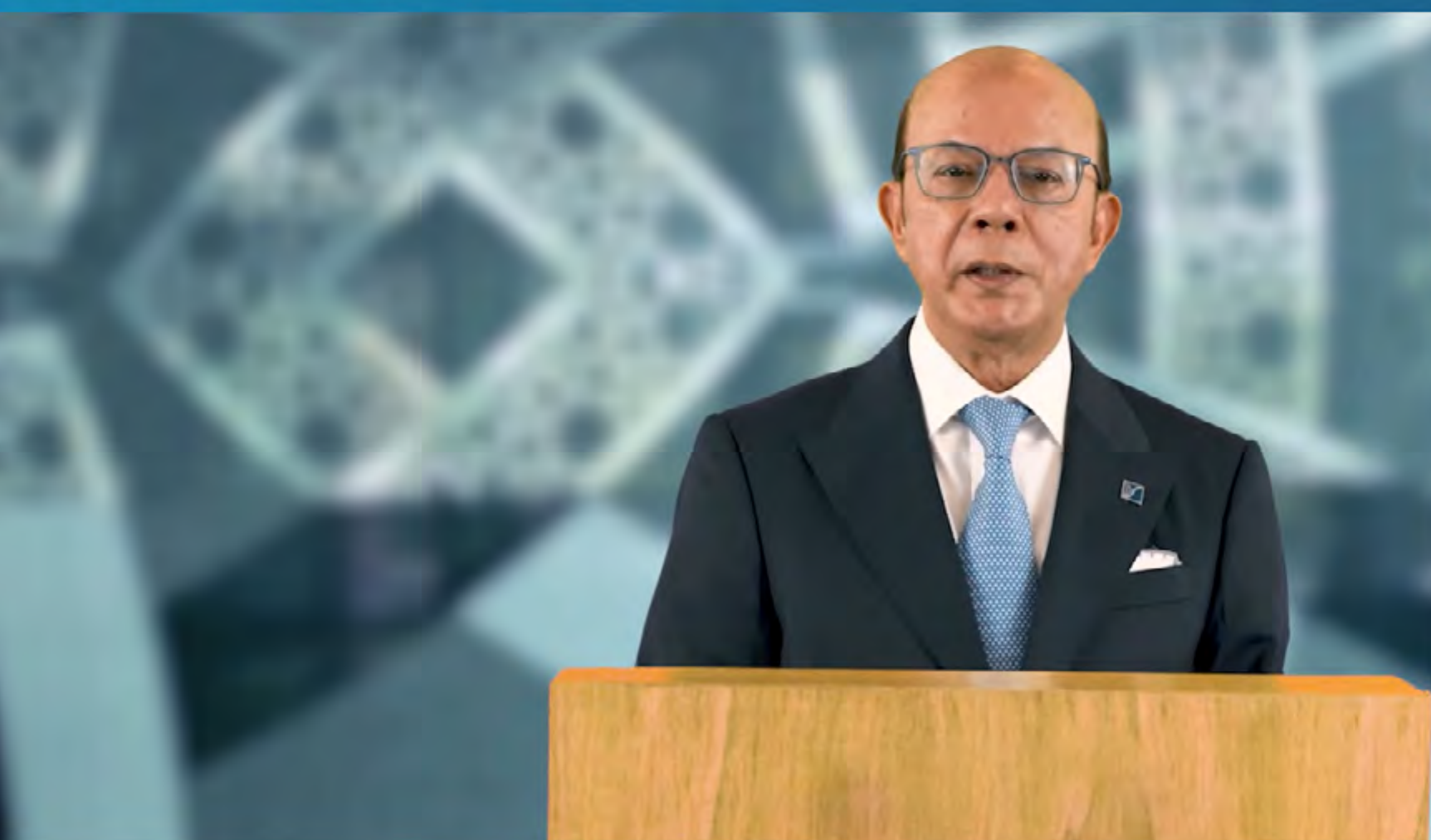

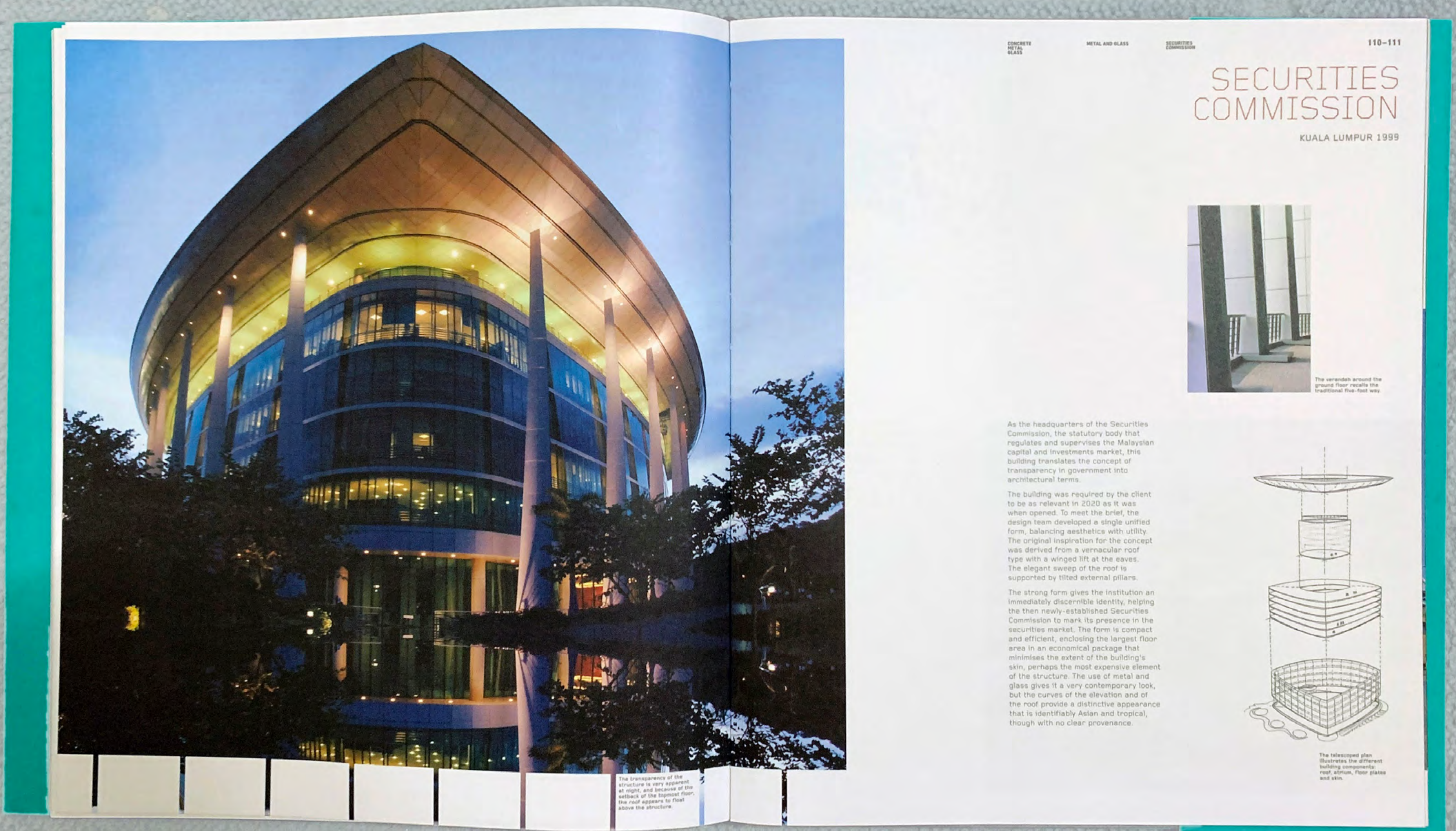
